From starting out in a fire hall and church basement, to moving into an 8,000 square foot building with 4 studios, our goals and dreams have been achieved beyond our wildest dreams!

This success could not be possible without hiring fabulous instructors through the years who have a passion and dedication for children and dance/acrobatics! Miss Becky Szimhart and Miss Sandy Brophy-Jordan have been with us since day one. Their devotion over the last 2.5 decades have contributed greatly to our growth and the heart of Premiere. If an instructor had to leave us, another great instructor came to take their place. We are currently approaching a whole new generation of staff ready and willing to take Premiere into the future and beyond, headed up by Miss Ashley, and several young instructors who are willing and anxious for our years ahead! The future of the studio is looking very bright! Along with professional instruction, being positive role models and leaders of example to our students is primary, and that will never change!

We also cannot forget to thank our staff of amazing women, led by our incredible office manager and dear friend Pat Young, who has been with us since Premiere 2. And most importantly, you, our student body and parents, who believe in what we are trying to accomplish for the sake of our children within this community.

This year's celebration encompasses more than your typical triumphs and trips down memory lane. This year's celebration encompasses the unwavering support and trust that surrounded us during 2020 and 2021 and all the obstacles we had to overcome in order to be here with you today!

It became very clear early on that there was no "rule book" or "manual" to follow. Encumbered by a pandemic and the tragedies that fell in its wake, all of us, worldwide, learned on the go. We turned to other studios, media resources, friends, family and industry professionals to best guide us through the process of outlining protocols and building policies. As things constantly shifted, we did our best to secure a safe environment for our staff and our students. We couldn't rely on the way we "used to" do things. Which, after 25 years, was a tried-and-true practice. We had to alter our mindset and think differently. We had to ask all of you to think differently with us. Instead of fighting the uncertainty, we chose to welcome the change. We had really hard days, faced with questions we couldn't answer and problems we couldn't solve. We realize you might not have understood the "why" behind some of the things we did, but our "why" was always in the best interest of your children, our students and our staff. We cannot thank you enough for your cooperation, your patience and your faith in us, our team and the values of Premiere. We have always known the significant impression that Premiere has the opportunity of making in the lives of our dancers and acrobats, however, this year especially unveiled the magnitude of our impact, not just physically, but also mentally.

"The next best thing to solving a problem, finding some humor in it!" And luckily we did. Like many, we could write a book about the absurdities we faced during Covid. Such as Miss Patti gracefully slipping and falling in her tap shoes while virtually teaching from home - or Miss Stacey virtually teaching 10-minutes of class before realizing the students were screaming out, "you are on MUTE!" And this season, never in a million years did we envision our costumes being stuck on a ship in the Suez Canal. Our younger dancers kept asking Miss Patti, "is the ship out yet?" At the most stressful of times for us, we tried our hardest to keep everything "FUN" for all of our students, we hope we accomplished that goal for your child!

Our dancers and acrobats (along with our teachers) have had to learn how to dance and tumble in masks. As you can imagine this added an entirely new element to their cardiovascular endurance and stamina. They have all been determined more than ever to keep dancing and flipping. We are all so excited to finally show you how hard we have been working to provide our community with a quality show!

Since it is our 25th Anniversary, all of the routine song choices made by our instructors are songs they choose from our past 24 years of shows - with new and updated choreography and ideas. We hope you enjoy what we all have chosen!

Tonight, as we gather here with all of you at our first ever outdoor dance Concert, we are proud to say that we were not only able to keep our doors open, but we were also able to keep our students dancing/tumbling, and our staff working. Premiere is a small business in a mighty community! We could not have done it without all of you. We danced through the darkness together. We tumbled through the troubles together. Alone we can do so little, together we can do so much. Let's celebrate together tonight!

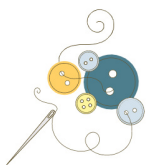

Our students learn many different acrobatic tricks throughout the year; however, it is the decision of both the instructor and student, based on certain criteria, which skills would be used in their routine. The Instructor and student have confidence that these tricks can be performed comfortably, safely, and consistently on their own without the assistance of instructors.

Acrobatics encompasses a number of tumbling moves ranging from forward rolls and cartwheels at level 1, through aerials and back tucks at the advanced level. With times so uncertain, and nothing seems clear!

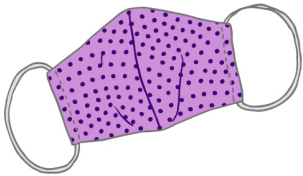
We started out fine, no worries at all,

Who could have known we would soon require masks!

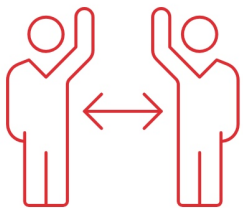
It happened so sudden, life came to a halt,
